COMPETITION'S RULES & INSTRUCTIONS

- The competition's duration is from 31/01/2026 to 12/02/2026
- Registration deadline is on 15/01/2026
- Prize winners and preliminary picks must stay in Fujairah until the final ceremony (12/02/2026 evening) in order to receive their prize.
- Registration is through the website www.ffaa.ae
- Contestants must submit the musical program of each round clearly while applying
- Contestants must submit a valid biography of no more than 100 words and an artistic photo in high resolution while applying
- The repertoire for each round MUST NOT exceed the maximum timing mentioned in the program instructions. The jury has the right to stop the performance and only a program performed within the authorized duration will be considered.
- All contestants and their guardians / teachers are strictly not allowed to contact the jury panel before announcement of the results.
- First prize winners must perform the specified concertos with an orchestra in the final ceremony
- To qualify for the final stage, each applicant should have achieved a ranking position in the round before
- The jury's decision is final and is not open for discussion
- The amount paid is not refundable
- By taking part in the "Fujairah International Piano Competition", participants consent to audio/video recordings during the auditioning & concerts.
- All materials submitted in the Fujairah International Piano Competition become the property of the Fujairah Fine Arts Academy and can later be used for the benefit of the Academy.




